The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed your letter dated April 30, 2008 regarding delisting certain parcels from the Central of Georgia Railroad - Battlefield Park site (HSI # 10590). We have also reviewed the latest groundwater results dated February 2007 and the June 27, 2008 correspondence, which includes the deed notice affidavit for corrective action for the above referenced site. Based on that review, I have determined that three parcels (Tracts A, B, and C) of this site are in compliance with non-residential risk reduction standards. Therefore, I am removing those three parcels from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with §391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules of Hazardous Site Response as of the date of this letter. Annual certification of the nonresidential status will still be required as indicated in the approved Continued Monitoring Plan for the site.

As required by §391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a public notice announcing this determination shall be published in Savannah Morning News.
