Dear Mr. Snyder and Mr. Stapleton:

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has completed its review of the attached laboratory analytical results of the groundwater sampled from down-gradient monitoring wells MW-3 and MW-1 and the soil sampling results submitted in your September 30, 2005 compliance status report. EPD has determined that the above site meets the residential (Type 1 and Type 2) risk reduction standards of Section 391-3-19-.07 of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules). Therefore, EPD is designating the site as not needing further action.

In accordance with Section 391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules, EPD is removing this site from the Hazardous Site Inventory (HSI) as of the date of this letter. As required by Rule 391-3-19-.06(5)(f), EPD will publish a public notice announcing this determination in The Champion Newspaper and The Atlanta Journal Constitution.
