The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has completed its investigation and cleanup actions for the above referenced site. Based on the results, I have determined that the site is now in compliance with Type 4 Risk Reduction Standards (non-residential standards). Since the site has already been classified as a Class III site and the City of Ideal has complied with Section 391-3-19-.08(4) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules), I am removing this site from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with §391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules as of the date of this letter.

Since the site is in compliance with non-residential cleanup standards, an annual inspection is needed to ensure the site maintains compliance with the Type 4 Risk Reduction Standards as required by Condition 1 of Consent Order EPD-HSR-538.

As required by §391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a public notice announcing this determination shall be published in *The Citizen Georgian* and the *Americus Times-Recorder*.
