The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has completed its review of the August 17, 2009 Groundwater Monitoring Report and the June 4, 2009 "Delisting Request," for the above-referenced site. Based on our review of available data, EPD has determined that a release exceeding a reportable quantity has not occurred at the site. Therefore, as of the date of this letter, the Director will remove the site from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with §391-3-19-.05(4)(a) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules).

EPD is not required to provide notice to the public of the removal of a site from the HSI when the removal is made pursuant to §391-3-19-.05(4)(a) of the Rules. If you wish to provide such notice, please provide a copy of the public notice to EPD for review and comment prior to publication.
