The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has completed its review of the Compliance Status Report (CSR) Addendum #2 dated January 2009 for the above referenced site. EPD concurs that the site complies with the Type 1 and Type 2 residential risk reduction standards (RRS) and the Type 3 non-residential RRS of §391-3-19-.07 of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules). A corrective action plan to maintain compliance with the Type 3 non-residential RRS (CAP) was approved in a letter dated February 12, 2009; copies of the appropriate deed notices were received on March 11, 2009; and Consent Order No. EPD-HSR-539 was executed to implement the approved CAP on August 10, 2009. An acceptable financial responsibility instrument and written cost estimate for the total estimated cost of performing the activities described in the approved CAP were received in a letter dated August 27, 2009. Therefore, EPD is removing the site from the Hazardous Site Inventory (HSI) pursuant to §391-3-19-.06(6)(b)(2) and §391-3-19-.05(4) of the Rules as of the date of this letter.

As required by Section 391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, EPD will publish a public notice announcing this determination in the Gwinnett Daily Post and the Atlanta Journal Constitution.
